

Technology Training Sessions

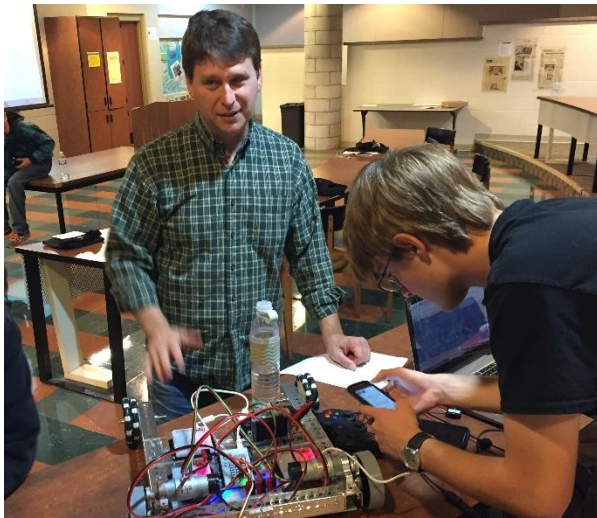
The following classes will be offered to current robotics team members and Greenwood students interested in joining our robotics team in grades 7 – 12:
